


Homework Grid

Read your work back to check it makes sense.</p>	<p>Write down all the number bonds to ten, test a sibling or adult to see if they can get them right.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$10 + 0 = 10$ $1 + 9 = 10$</p>	<p>Practise your letter and number formation.
