


Think of as many interesting adjectives that you can to describe your alien.</p>	<p>Practise your handwriting. Write something in your neatest handwriting. Remember to start each letter from the line.</p>
<p>Practise adding any 2 numbers to 20 as quick as a flash. Try to do some subtractions too.</p>	<p>Practise spelling words with the 'ed' suffix- with the 't' sound walked, talked and asked. How many more can you think of?</p> 	<p>Design a poster about how to keep your bodies clean.</p>	<p>Children in Year 2 should be able to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Practise with an adult. If you can have ago at counting in 3s.</p>
<p>Practise maths using http://www.mymaths.co.uk</p> 	<p>Do you know all of your doubles to 20? What about your halves? Practise doubling and halving with a family member. Can you learn them off by heart?</p>	<p>Write some lists of your favourite foods. Remember to separate each item with a comma and don't use a comma with an 'and'.</p>	<p>Play 'guess my shape'. Children can pick a 3D shape and describe it to their adults. Children can describe how many edges, vertices (corners), and faces the shape has.</p>
<p>Pretend that you are a Victorian teacher and write a list of commands.</p>	<p>Practise spelling the common exception words for Year 2.
